INTERNET & NETWORK ACCESS

Wyoming Seminary provides computers with high-speed Internet access for student use in the Kirby Library, Sprague computer lab, Sprague mobile lab, Nesbitt classrooms and dormitory lounges. Dormitory rooms have data ports with Internet/network access for use with student-owned machines. Each student will be provided with a school e-mail account.

Internet Policies: Web sites dealing with, but not limited to, pornographic content, hacking, and peer-to-peer networks are restricted. The Acceptable Use Policy is in the Student/Parent Handbook; each student is expected to read this policy and adhere to its conditions before network access is granted. For more information on what is restricted, please contact the IT Department by submitting a Help Desk ticket on the IT Department Web site.

VOICE NETWORK

Wyoming Seminary provides voice access and voice mailboxes for each boarding student, upon request only, from the IT Department.

Local and 800# calls are free from dorm phones, but a student who plans to make long-distance calls should have a calling card or mobile (cell) phone.

Emergencies: In case of an emergency, you may contact a dorm leader or one of the deans. Please see the Parent/Student Handbook for numbers.

Dormitory phone hours - Dorm room phones are active at all times.

REQUIRED OPERATING SYSTEMS

Student-owned computers must have an **English** version of one of the following operating systems installed before Internet/network access is granted:

Microsoft Windows

Apple OS X

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- XP Professional
 - XP Professional w/Media Center
 - Vista Business & Ultimate
 - 7 Professional & Ultimate

Important: Any version of Windows Home Edition is not permitted for use on the Wyoming Seminary network. If a student brings a computer on campus that does not meet our requirements, he/she will not have network/Internet access until the machine is upgraded.* This is at additional cost to the student. Windows 7 upgrades (now downloadable) can be purchased at a discounted price through JourneyEd.
